How do I choose the correct size?

We suggest your team schedule to order a fit kit or if your team has already held their fitting you can use the size chart. Men or boys should measure around their hips and women should measure their torso to order the correct size. Suits for competition should fit slightly snug

My suit feels smaller than the fit kit suit I tried on. What should I do?

All of our suits are custom made to order that means they are will fit a little bit tight in the beginning. But after wearing them a few times they will stretch to fit and mold to your body.

How long does it take to have my suit delivered?

All of our suits are handmade to order. Due to the technical construction of the swimwear it takes roughly 7-10 days to manufacture and 3-5 days to ship. We do our best to manufacture as quick as possible. It is very important to us that all athletes receive their suits in time for competition.



Will my order ship all together?

When will my order ship?

Ryte Sport products are handmade to order. Your order will ship after manufacturing is complete (typically 7-10 business days).
